

STEPS TO TAKE

To Start Your Official Detroit Block Club

1

Contact your Deputy District Manager or complete a pre-registration form online.

Recruit a core group from your neighborhood who are willing to advocate and carry out goals.

3

Set your meeting dates. Invite your Deputy District Manager to the First 2 formation meetings.

4

Decide your boundaries and form a leadership team (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer)
